O R D E R

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that four co-accused have been granted anticipatory bail and, therefore, on the basis of parity, the petitioner should be granted bail.
2. Issue notice, returnable in four weeks.

3. In addition to the usual mode, liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve notice through the Standing Counsel for the respondent/State.

4. The Grant of anticipatory bail in cases involving Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) is a very serious issue. We, therefore, direct the State to consider as to whether it proposes to file an application for the cancellation of bail granted to the other co-accused.
